
One Mill

Materials





Merino Wool

We believe Merino Wool is one of the best materials for manufacturing our socks. It is thermo regulated, it stays warm and retains its shape when wet and it's non-itchy and won't stink. We work closely with our suppliers from America and around the world to ensure that we receive only sustainably sourced Merino Wool from sheep that are not exposed to the practice of mulesing.

Thermolite®

A synthetic insulated material specially engineered to provide warmth and comfort without weight. Thermolite® is designed to dry fast and absorb any moisture, while keeping your feet warm when needed.

Coolmax® A polyeste

A polyester fabric engineered to move moisture away from your skin and dry fast in warm conditions. It is designed to improve breathability compared with natural fibres.



Weight Classes

Darn Tough Socks come in four distinct weights: Ultra-Lightweight, Lightweight, Midweight and Heavyweight. Weights are determined by the type of yarn used and how the sock is knit.

Ultra-Lightweight For the lowest profile socks Sock categories : Run, Vertical and Bike



Lightweight For most activities Sock categories : Hike/Trek, Vertical, Tactical, Lifestyle and Athletic

Midweight For warmth Sock categories : Hike/Trek, Vertical, Tactical, Hunt and Work

Heavyweight For maximum warmth Sock categories : Hike/Trek, Tactical and Hunt



Cushion Types

A sock's level of cushion and placement is a deciding factor for personal comfort and performance. Terry loops create the cushion and location defines the level.



No Cushion

Thin knit with no lift from terry loops Sock categories : Hike/Trek, Tactical, Run, Vertical, Lifestyle and Athletic



Cushion

Terry loop knit found underfoot and strategic zones Sock categories : Run, Lifestyle, Athletic, Hike/Trek, Tactical, Hunt, Vertical and Work



Full Cushion

Cushioned terry loops running the length of the sock Sock categories : Hike/Trek, Tactical, Work



Go With The Flow

Graduated Light Compression is a go-to for athletes, travelers, and anyone on their feet all day benefitting from the increase in blood flow from the ankles back to the heart. That's been our experience. Add Darn Tough knitting, Merino Wool, and pure savvy and it was time to extend into styles across categories. Strongest at the ankle and lighter as you move up the leg.



15-20 mmHg

- The sweet spot, aka All-Day Compression.
- Great for minor or occasional swelling.
- Recommended for reducing swelling and preventing blood clots during travel.
- Most popular in sports running, gym, you name it.



Graduated Light Compression

Strongest at the ankle and lighter as you move up the leg. Perfect for a full day.


